PHAGE TRIAL

Cystic fibrosis patients are at risk for antibiotic-resistant bacteria. Phage therapy uses viruses to attack difficult-to-treat bacteria. We are conducting a clinical trial to determine if the use of phage can improve the health of patients with CF with *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* in their sputum.
